

## Role Profile - Student Trustee

**Term:** One/two year, July 2019 until July 2020/21

**Hours:** Part-time - there are one to two Trustee Board meetings per term

**Location:** Middlesex University London, Hendon

**Who can stand?** This is a part-time role which you can fulfil alongside your studies, and is open to all registered Middlesex University London students

### Outline of the role

As a non-profit, charitable organisation, the work of Middlesex Students' Union is overseen by a Trustee Board - MDXSU's highest governing body.

If you love the idea of making high-level decisions for an award-winning organisation with 18,000 members, or you want to learn more about business and strategy in a real environment (or maybe put your existing knowledge to good use), then this is the position for you.

If elected as one of our Student Trustees, you will attend Trustee Board meetings roughly twice a term throughout the year, sitting alongside the four full-time Student Officers and our expert external trustees to discuss finances, strategy and long term goals for your Students' Union.

This is a part-time student role, which you can fulfill alongside your studies.

### Nominating yourself

To put yourself forward for an elected position, you must nominate yourself online by **midday Friday 22 February**. Please visit [www.mdxsu.com/nominate](http://www.mdxsu.com/nominate) and sign in using your university login, then complete a short nomination form. You have until **midday Monday 25 February** to submit a manifesto – a statement outlining who you are and what you want to achieve if elected.

Voting will be open between **10am Monday 1 March and 2pm Friday 7 March**. During this period, students will be able to vote for which candidates they want to get elected – and you'll have the chance to tell them why it should be you!
